How to apply to attend the National Schools' Constitutional Convention
19-21 March 2019, Canberra

The National Schools' Constitutional Convention (NSCC) is one of the major components of the Australian Government Civics and Citizenship Education (CCE) programme. The NSCC is an annual peak event exploring the Australian Constitution for senior school students in Years 11 and 12. Approximately 120 students from Years 11 and 12, selected from state and territory conventions, attend the NSCC each year.

The 2018 Convention will be held at Old Parliament House, Canberra and accommodation will be at Mantra Macarthur Hotel.

More than 120 delegates from all states and territories will convene in Old Parliament House to explore the topic – A new constitutional preamble for Australia?

Up to 25 delegates from the 2018 Victorian Secondary Schools' Parliamentary Convention will be selected to attend this event. The Department is now inviting applications for supervisors to accompany the students to the National Convention in Canberra.

A supervisor must be a registered teacher who is willing and able to actively supervise all the Victorian students for the full duration of the three day program. While attending the Convention is a rewarding and valuable professional learning opportunity, applicants should be aware that the schedule of events is demanding with little opportunity for free time.

The cost of airfares, accommodation and meals will be met by the Australian Government Department of Education and Training. Teacher release funds are not provided.

If your students participated in the 2018 Secondary Schools' Parliamentary Convention (held at Parliament House, Melbourne on 12 September 2018) or a local convention, you are invited to apply to attend the 2019 National Schools' Constitutional Convention as a supervisor.
